



Free equipment that we can provide during a home fire safety visit:

Individual smoke, heat and carbon monoxide alarms



Dementia wrist bands

Programmed with the persons details that can be scanned by emergency services to help people get home safely.



Hard of hearing alarm

For people who are hard of hearing or deaf. The device consists of a vibrating pad and strobe lights that are synced to the smoke detector.



Lockable letter boxes

For people who are at risk of arson.



Fire retardant bedding

For those who are at risk of fires starting in their bed i.e smoking or use emollient/flammable creams.
